Home School Agreement




Staff will:

- Inspire, engage and challenge children to reach their full potential as part of a broad and balanced curriculum.
- Provide a balanced, stimulating and well taught curriculum to meet the individual needs of a child.
- Respect and value each child as part of the school community.
- Encourage children to have self belief and develop a sense of responsibility.
- Provide a safe, secure and happy environment
- Keep parents/carers informed about general school matters and in particular, their child's progress with learning and targets through regular meetings.
- Inform parents/carers of any concerns we have about their child's general performance, behaviour and welfare.
- Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the daily life of the school.
- Provide parents with information on topics being taught and how they can help.

Parents/Carers will:

- Make sure their child attends school regularly, punctually and properly equipped (arrive between 8.30 and 8.45 and collect at 3.05).
- Provide a basic PE kit in school: plimsolls, dark shorts and plain white top, outdoor games kits when required and appropriate swimming costumes.
- Inform the school on the first day of any absence and provide a written note on a child's return to school.
- Inform school of any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour in school.
- Follow the school's policies and guidelines for homework, behaviour, jewellery and dress.
- Support and promote the school's Behaviour Policy for the benefit of all.
- Support their child with homework, achieving their targets and other home learning opportunities.
- Make every effort to attend parent consultations about my child's progress.
- Take as active a role in the school as possible.



Children

I will:

- Attend school daily and arrive on time.
- Wear the correct school uniform, take pride in my appearance and remember that I represent my school at all times.
- Bring my reading book and diary to school every day.
- Do all classwork and homework to the best of my ability and hand homework in on time.
- Challenge myself to do 'that little bit more' to achieve my potential.
- Know my targets and work hard to achieve them.
- Be kind, honest, trustworthy, polite and helpful to others.
- Be well behaved and sensible.
- Take care not to hurt anyone by what I say or do.
- Take care of my school and class environment and everything in it.
- Follow instructions the first time they are given.
- Work as a member of a team, respecting the differences of others.
- Give letters, information and newsletters to my parents/carers or bring them in to my teachers.

If I have a problem or any worries:

- I will try talking to the other person to see if I can sort the problem out on my own.
- I will tell an adult as soon as I can.

Together we will:

- Share any concerns or problems that might affect your child's work or behaviour.
- Build each child's confidence and self esteem.
- Celebrate the achievement of each child.
- Listen to each other's concerns and act on them as soon as possible.
- Take pride in our school.
