<b>Autumn 1</b>	<p><b>Creation /Fall</b> using Understanding Christianity resource Core Learning. Building blocks – Christians believe:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• God the Creator cares for creation including human beings.</li> <li>• Humans do best when they listen to God.</li> <li>• Bible story about humans spoiled friendship with God (the Fall).</li> <li>• Humans can't get close to God without His help.</li> <li>• The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him.</li> <li>• Christians show that they want to be close to God through obedience, worship and saying sorry.</li> </ul>	<p><b>People of God</b> using Understanding Christianity resource Core Learning. Building blocks – Christians believe:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Old Testament tells the story of Israel, known as the people of God.</li> <li>• The People of God try to live in the way God wants.</li> <li>• Bible stories show how God keeps his promises.</li> <li>• The Old Testament narrative explains that the People of God are meant to show the benefits of having a relationship with God and to attract other nations to worshipping God.</li> </ul>
