Thank you to those who managed to attend our meeting about life in years 5 and 6 on Thursday. As discussed in the meeting, and for those unable to attend, here are the costings for the trip to see Wicked the musical on 8th December 2021 and the Isle of Wight residential on May 16th 2022.

We try to keep costs for these trips as low as we can and we are very lucky that we have secured a significant amount of funding to go towards the Isle of Wight trip. This means that the trip can be subsidised for all children and costs reduced to £350. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please talk to the office about your payment.

In the hope of aiding parents further, we have set up a payment schedule for both trips, to enable you to spread the cost across a number of months. Should you wish to, you will also be able to pay in full at anytime. Payment is to be made via school money. You will be able to make the first payment from Monday 20th of September.
