Every child, who attends one of our Vine schools, will receive a Vine Passport. This Vine Passport will give every child the opportunity to challenge themselves, to broaden their horizons and to increase their life experiences. There is a total of 40 challenges as you travel around your Vine Schools Passport. There is no rush to complete it all at once; indulge yourself in the challenges and enjoy!

On the Vine Passport, you will see that there are 8 Zones;

- 4. Time to reflect (Spirituality)
- 5. Healthy body, healthy mind!
- 6. Predicting and testing! (Science and Technology)
- 7. What a wonderful world!
- 8. Taking care of each other!

Within each Zone, there are 5 separate challenges. You will need to complete all 5 challenges to achieve the Zone. Once you have achieved all the challenges in each zone, this zone is completed and you will earn a Zone badge!

Each half term, teachers will check your Vine Passports and present the Zone Badges. These achievements will then be shared with the Vine Schools Trust, and you could end up featuring in our half termly Passport Newsletter!

If you feel you have achieved one of the challenges, you will need to show this to your teacher so that they can give you the sticker to mark it off. You might bring in a piece of work, a photo or share something via your school's online platform for example.
