Dear Parents and Carers,

Today, your **children will be bringing home a letter from their class teacher for next year**. 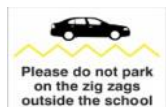
School dinners - bookings can now be made until the end of the summer term

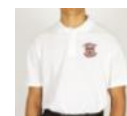
