Dear Parents / Carers,

We are fast approaching the end of term and your child has only three weeks of primary school left. Whilst this may seem a sad and rather daunting event, there is much to celebrate!

Today, the children's end of key stage SAT results were released. All of the children worked incredibly hard this year and should celebrate their own personal successes. We are very proud of them. Your child will be given a slip with their results on. This table gives a brief description of how the results are levelled:

Working towards the expected standard	WT	0 -99
Working at the expected standard (age related expectation)	ARE	100 - 109
Working at greater depth within the expected standard	GD	110 +

We are busy rehearsing for our year 6 production of Ali Baba and the Bongo Bandits. I am sure you are already familiar with some of the songs!

There will be two performances:

Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July 1.30pm to 3pm.

Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 6pm – 7.30pm (children to arrive at school – at Miss Salmon's classroom at 5.30pm)

Tickets are in the form of a programme and cost £1.00 each. This payment will cover the costs of costumes and props. For year 6 children, you may book two tickets per family, per performance. Eg: One year 6 child, can book two tickets for Tuesday afternoon and two tickets for Wednesday evening. Pre-school aged children will need to sit on laps.

Tickets will be available to booked online from Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> July until Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July at 3pm. From Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July, all remaining tickets will be allocated to the children in year 5. Please collect your ticket / programme at the office on your way into the performance.

On Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> July all year 6 children are invited to a leaver's barbecue and bounce. This starts at 5pm and finishes at 6.30pm. The children will have a disco dome and barbecue, so no need for dinner that night!

On their final day at school – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July – we are inviting families to come and say goodbye at our 'Leavers' Worship'. This is where the children are given their hoodies and autograph books. The children will be able to get their shirts signed during the day, but please send them in with a clean top to wear during the service. Full school uniform is expected. Please arrive at 2.15pm. You will then be able to take your children home at 3pm.
